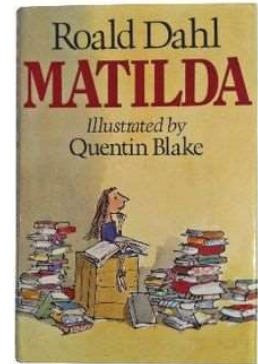
## Red Pandas By Jules D. Section 45
